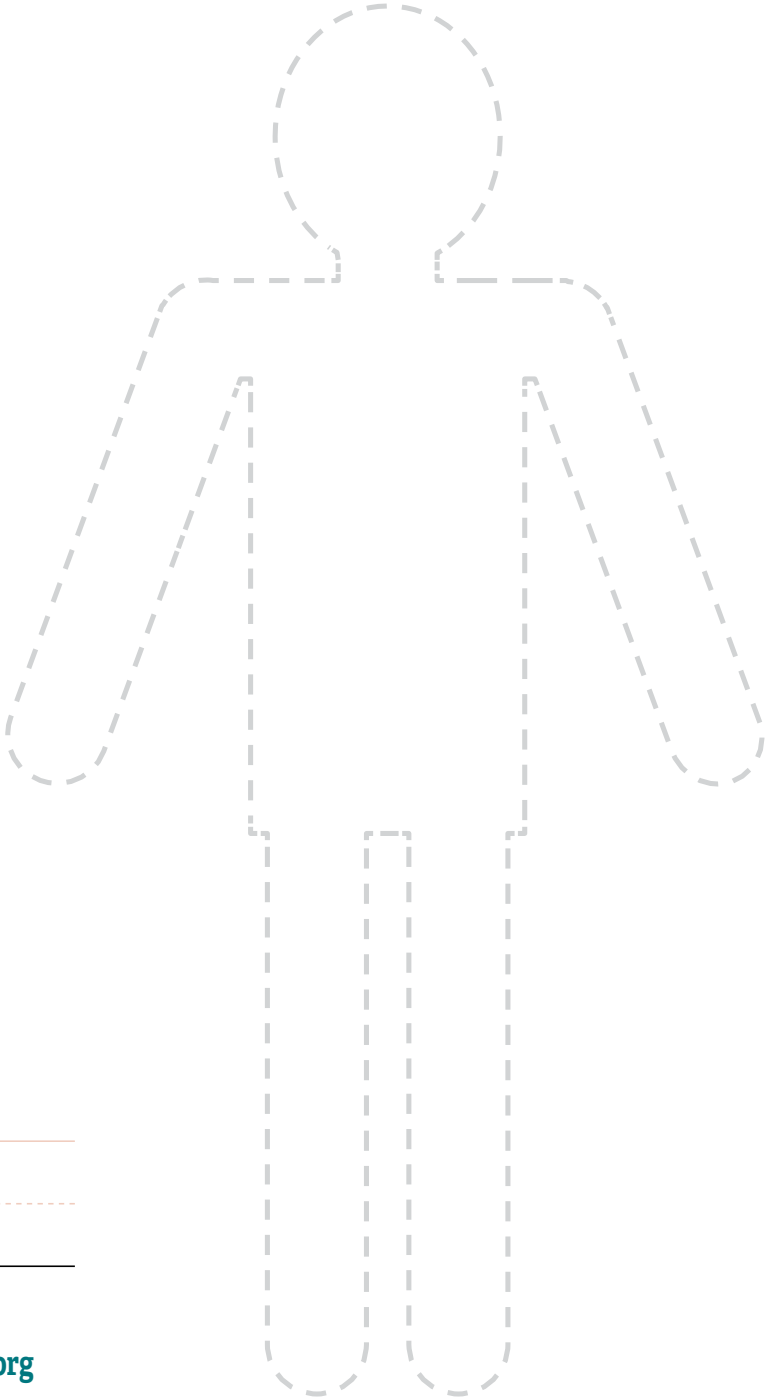


Be a
CAREER EXPLORER

What does your son or daughter want to be when he or she grows up?

Help your child be a career explorer. Give your child blank paper (or use the space to the right) and some crayons or markers. Name some of the places you both go, such as school, restaurants, stores or a bank, and talk about the jobs of people there.
