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Dress For Your Future

Use College GO! to have students explore what they want to be when they grow up. Consider the activities below to encourage career exploration.

1. Use College GO! as an opportunity to have students come to school dressed as the person/action figure/hero/shero/job they want to have when they grow up. Use this as a “show and tell” where each student has an opportunity to tell who/what their costume represents and why this inspires them.
2. Have each student find a picture of someone performing a job that appeals to them. It can be cut from a magazine or newspaper or printed off from a computer. Give each student an opportunity to share why this career interests them.
3. Print off pictures of people performing various careers (10-15 careers) and make 3-5 copies of each image. Then, divide students into 3-5 groups and ask them to group similar careers together. Ask each group to share which careers they grouped together and why.
