

## DRESS FOR YOUR FUTURE

**Use College GO! to have students explore what they want to be when they grow up. Consider the activities below to encourage career exploration.**

# 1

Use College GO! as an opportunity to have students come to school dressed as the person/action figure/hero/shero/job they want to have when they grow up. Use this as a “show and tell” where each student has an opportunity to tell who/what their costume represents and why this inspires them.

# 2

Have each student find a picture of someone performing a job that appeals to them. It can be cut from a magazine or newspaper or printed off from a computer. Give each student an opportunity to share why this career interests them.

# 3

Print off pictures of people performing various careers (10-15 careers) and make 3-5 copies of each image. Then, divide students into 3-5 groups and ask them to group similar careers together. Ask each group to share which careers they grouped together and why.
