Have you heard about the **Indiana Pre-Admissions: Your Path to College** initiative? This is an exciting opportunity for you to explore your options after high school. Whether you are interested in a short-term training program, a four-year degree, or something in between, Indiana Pre-Admissions can help you find your next step after graduation.



## What is the Indiana Pre-Admissions: Your Path to College initiative?

This program offers you the chance to be pre-admitted to select Indiana colleges during your senior year using your cumulative GPA, your SAT score, and/or diploma type. You will receive a letter in the mail the fall of your senior year that includes instructions for how to participate.



#### Is your school offering the Enrollment Honors Plus Seal?

As part of Indiana Pre-Admissions, graduating with the Indiana Diploma with the Enrollment Honors Plus Seal offers the chance to be admitted to all Indiana public colleges and universities, as well as any private Indiana colleges that opt in to the program. These matches will be included in your Indiana Pre-Admissions letter, indicated with an asterick (\*). Check with your school counselor to see if your school is offering this opportunity.

## What colleges can you be pre-admitted to through this program?

More than 40 public and private colleges in Indiana are participating this year in the Indiana Pre-Admissions and Indiana Resident Admissions initiatives. You can find a full list of the 2026 participating campuses through the QR code below.

#### What can you do now as a 9th grader to prepare for college?

- ☐ Meet with your school counselor at the beginning of the school year to ensure your graduation plan reflects your college and career goals. If you are considering college after high school, ask about the Enrollment Honors Plus Seal diploma pathway so that you can take advantage of Indiana Resident Admissions.
- Consider participating in an extracurricular or service activity. Extracurricular activities at school are a great way to meet students with similar interests. You can also get involved in various service activities in your community, such as through church, a local youth organization, or a community center.
- □ Check if your school offers the Indiana College Core. The Indiana College Core is a block of courses you can take in high school that can count for up to a full year of college. This can save you time earning your degree and it can save you a lot of money. Visit MyCollegeCore.org to see if your school offers the Indiana College Core.
- It's never too early to take your GPA seriously! We encourage you to stay focused on your academic performance.
